**JERRY LEE LEWIS' LAST MAN STANDING LIVE DVD INCLUDES  
EXCLUSIVE LIVE PERFORMANCES FROM SOME OF MUSIC'S GREATEST  
LEGENDS**

LOS ANGELES, CA MARCH 5, 2007— Following the tremendously successful release of his #1 Independent charted album *Last Man Standing* last fall, tomorrow, March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2007 Artists First and Shangri-La Entertainment will be releasing a very special Jerry Lee Lewis Live DVD. *Jerry Lee Lewis Last Man Standing LIVE* is history in the making featuring a Rolling Stone, a couple of Jones, an Eagle and a man on a throne.

Lewis proves yet again that he doesn't get older; The Killer keeps getting bolder. For the filming of this unique, live DVD, he gathered with friends, family and rock 'n' roll icons to perform at a series of private shows in New York and Los Angeles. Rock 'n' roll, soul and country music legends gathered from the world 'round to show their admiration for one of the great original song stylists of all time. *Last Man Standing LIVE* is an intimate and unprecedented event in music history, which includes interviews, as well as documentary and archival footage.

The DVD's roster of music all-stars includes 11 Grammy winners with 36 awards among them, six members of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, one member of the Rockabilly Hall of Fame, and three members of the Country Music Hall of Fame. The guest artists are Willie Nelson, Tom Jones, Chris Isaak, Norah Jones, Buddy Guy, Solomon Burke, Merle Haggard, Kid Rock, Kris Kristofferson, Ron Wood, Don Henley, and John Fogerty.

Lewis and his peers were backed by an all-star band throughout the filming of these performances including Jim Keltner on drums, Rick Rosas on bass, Nils Lofgren on guitar and pedal steel, Ken Lovelace and Jimmy Rip on guitar, Ivan Neville on organ and piano, and Maxayn Lewis, Stacie Plunk, and Charlotte Gibson singing backup. Keltner is a legendary drummer who has worked with Rock 'n' Roll's all time greats including John Lennon, George Harrison, Ringo Starr, Eric Clapton, Joe Cocker, the Rolling Stones, Bob Dylan, Neil Young and more. Lofgren is a well respected solo artist in his own right who has worked with some of rock's most celebrated acts including as a member of Bruce Springsteen's E Street Band. Neville, who is part of New Orleans' most famous musical family, is an accomplished solo artist and full time member of the Neville Brothers with his father Aaron. Rip, who produced Lewis's *Last Man Standing*, is one of the most sought after session guitarists and producers who can be heard on albums by Mick Jagger, Rod Stewart, and Debbie Harry. Last, but not least, Lovelace is a highly regarded Nashville session guitarist who will mark his 40<sup>th</sup> year as Jerry Lee's bandleader this May.

A related television special is airing exclusively on the PBS network nationwide. The special began on March 3, 2007 as a "Great Performances" special and will air during the network's spring pledge drive through March 18, 2007.

A special double disc version will be released at the same time as the DVD, featuring the DVD plus an audio CD with 8 never-before-released live recordings of some of Lewis' all time greats.

Lewis' critically acclaimed album *Last Man Standing* debuted at #1 on the Billboard Top Independent Album Chart, at #4 on the Billboard Top Country Album Chart and at #26 on the Billboard Top 200 Album Chart in the first week of its release. *Last Man Standing*, which has sold over 325,000 to date worldwide, ended 2006 on Billboard's Top 25 Independent Albums Of The Year. The star-studded album, which features 15 members of the Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame including Lewis himself, has shipped nearly 400,000 thousand units and hit #6 on the Americana Radio Charts. *The Killer* has made his comeback.

***Last Man Standing*** has been widely praised: “Jerry Lee Lewis reinforces his status as one of rock 'n' roll's founding fathers” according to *Vanity Fair*; Randy Lewis of the *Los Angeles Times* raves “[Jimmy Rip and Steve Bing] succeeded in capturing him sounding more feisty and singularly expressive at 71 than anyone could reasonably imagine” and Jon Pareles of the *New York Times* says, “The album is packed with rock-star guests...and Mr. Lewis easily dominates them all.” Chuck Young writes in *Rolling Stone*, “The only guy in all of music who makes Keith Richards look about as dangerous as Jessica Simpson, the Killer continues to rage into the night” and Edna Gundersen of *USA Today* praises “On *Standing*, the tenacious Lewis still sounds like a swaggering, defiant champion with no intention of relinquishing his belt anytime soon.”
